Danger building works in progress Over the coming weeks parents and carers will notice that a few different aspects of building work will be taking place around school. As a school, a bid was placed with the Education Authorities' Minor Works Department, in order to better develop the security of our school site. The initial application for the works was submitted in March 2018 and I am delighted that our bid has been successful. Additional fencing will be added around the front playground as well as along the edge of the car park and at the rear of the school canteen to ensure that visitors to school cannot gain access to any area of the school site apart from the main front entrance. The current school office will be demolished and a new, purpose built office and visitor waiting area will be built. Once I have been given a start date by the Education Authority, I will write to parents / carers to advise them of alternative, short term access arrangements.



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Just before the Christmas holidays, Mrs Orr applied for a grant from the National Lottery in order to help redevelop the outside play area and classroom at the rear of the Primary 1 classroom block. Within the Northern Ireland Curriculum, children should have the opportunity, particularly in Nursery and Primary 1, to develop their learning outdoors. We are delighted to let the school community know that the National Lottery have awarded school <u>£10,000</u> to help develop this outdoor area.

Mrs Orr has been in talks with several companies in order to get the best prices for what we want....believe it or not, £10000 doesn't go a very long way but we are delighted that we can make a start in our redevelopment.

This design from one of the companies Mrs Orr has been in touch with gives you a bit of an idea as to what the grant money will be spent on.

Construction will start in approx. 6 weeks' time and WE CAN'T WAIT!!!!
