# Houston, we have a problem...

Parents / carers will be aware that we recently changed our school holiday dates for May this year.

This was as a result of the electoral office informing school that a local election would be held on Thursday 4th May and that an additional bank holiday was being applied in celebration of the King's Coronation. The decision to change the school holiday dates was to try and limit the number of broken weeks in school in May - especially as this is the time of year when children complete their end of year assessments.

Since making the change to the holiday list, the Northern Ireland Office has changed the date of the election. This is because the count from the election would run into the King's Coronation day.

So, as to not confuse thing any further, and make more changes to the holiday dates, as well as to try to continue to limit the number of broken teaching weeks in May, school will continue to be closed on Thursday 4th May, which means school will continue to be closed for that full week.

In order to make back any lost time, school will not close for half days at the end of term before Easter and Summer holidays as previously planned. School will remain open until normal time on both these days. Also, should parents wish, some additional work will be sent home with pupils over the May week holiday.
