Pre-loved Christmas Jumpers

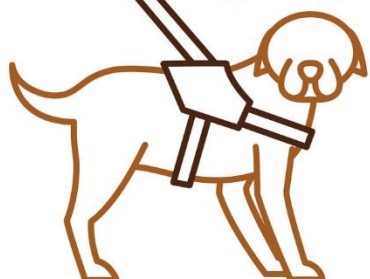
Our wonderful PTA will be operating a pre-loved Christmas jumper stall this year.
